ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 1

DISCHARGE OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS ORDINANCE - FIRST AMENDMENT

An Ordinance to amend the Charter Township of Hampton Discharge of Dangerous Weapons Ordinance, being the Charter Township of Hampton Ordinance No. 19, by amending Sections 2 and 4 of Said Ordinance No. 19.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON, BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Discharge of Dangerous Weapons Ordinance - First Amendment".

SECTION 2. Amendment to Ordinance No. 19, Section 2. - Prohibited Area.

The within Ordinance prohibits the discharge of dangerous weapons in the following area of the Township: That area of the Township which lies West of a line beginning on the South line of Youngs Ditch Road due South of the center of the intersection of Pine Road and Youngs Ditch Road, running thence Northerly along the center line of Pine Road to the center line of Ridge Road; thence Easterly along the center line of Ridge Road to the center line of Jones Road; thence Northerly along the center line of Jones Road to the center line of Arms Road; thence Westerly to the center line of Boutell Road; thence Northerly along the center line of Boutell Road; thence the Saginaw Bay.

SECTION 3. Amendment to Ordinance No. 19, Section 4. - Penalty.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ninety (90) days or both, such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day after publication following adoption, as required by law.
