## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_ CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON COUNTY OF BAY MICHIGAN

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON, COUNTY OF BAY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

Section 1: There shall be added to Ordinance No. 4 of said Charter Township a new Section 26a, said Section to read as follows:

Section 26a: Any monies derived from rates and charges collected for use of the township water system, in excess of requirements to meet expenses of operation and maintenance of said system, may, in the discretion of the Township Board, be used to pay part or all of the cost of constructing additions and improvements to said system, by direct cash contribution or use of such monies as a revolving fund or any other lawful means approved by the Township Board.

Section 2: All ordinances or resolutions or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: If any paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other paragraph, clause, or provision hereof.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be published in full in a newspaper of general circulation in the township qualified under State law to publish legal

notices, within two (2) weeks after its adoption, and the same shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Supervisor and Township Clerk. Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective I hereby certify that the foregoing constitutes a true and complete copy of Ordinance No. 5, duly adopted by the Township Board of the Charter Township of Hampton, at a Regular Meeting held on July 11, 1962, at which all members were present, I further certify that member <u>Quarter</u> moved adoption of said Ordinance, and that member \_ Badouy supported said motion.
