

Proper Cart Placement is the Key to Automated Service



- Have your cart at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place the cart at least 3 feet from other objects like trees, poles, fire hydrants, mailboxes, electrical boxes, cable boxes, etc., and at least 3 feet away from cars so the automated arm can reach your cart.
- Please have this same distance of 3 feet between your recycling and waste carts.
- Don't lean anything against the cart.
- Don't place your cart under a tree.
- Place carts one foot from the curb or edge of the street.
- Remember to have the handle toward your house, with the lid closed.
- Please don't allow children to play in or around the carts. Republic Services® trucks use mechanical arms to pick up the recycling and waste carts.
- Do not put paint, hot ashes, light bulbs, computer screens/keyboards or other electronic items with a plug in your recycling carts.

Waste should be placed in the waste cart provided and should not exceed 50 pounds.

Recyclable materials should be placed in the recycling cart provided and used just for recyclable materials.

Bulk items such as furniture, appliances and yard toys should be separated from all other household recycling and waste materials, and placed at the curb three (3) feet away from the recycling and waste carts.
