

Proper Cart Placement



- Have your cart at the curb, by 6 a.m., on your collection day. You may set your cart out the night before, if you wish.
- Place the cart at least 3 feet from other objects like trees, poles, fire hydrants, mailboxes, electrical boxes, cable boxes, etc., and at least 3 feet away from cars. This allows the automated arm to reach your cart and avoid obstacles.
- Please have this same distance of 3 feet between your recycling and waste carts.
- Don't lean anything against the cart.
- Place carts 2 feet from the curb or edge of the street. Do not put cart in pedestrian walk path.
- Remember to have the **handle toward your house**, with the lid closed.
- Children should not be permitted to play in or around the carts. Republic Services® trucks use mechanical arms to pick up carts.
- Do not put paint, hot ashes, light bulbs, computer screens/keyboards or other electronic items with a plug in your recycling carts.

Waste should be placed in the waste cart provided and should not exceed 175 pounds.

All trash must be in bagged and not loose in the cart.

If you have bags, that don't fit in the cart, they should not exceed 50 pounds.

Recyclable materials should be placed in the recycling cart provided and used just for recyclable materials. **All recycling must be loose in the cart. Glass is best placed in a box and shredded paper should be placed in paper bag.**

Bulk items such as furniture, appliances and yard toys should be separated from all other household recycling and waste materials and placed at the curb three (3) feet away from the recycling and waste carts. One (1) item per week is allowed. Trucks may return at the end of the day. The driver may need to request a "large item truck" to remove a bulk item. They should return within 5 business days to pick up.

As part of your curbside service, a **White Feather Landfill Pass** is available at the Hampton Township Office. One (1) pass is allowed per month.
